Welcome Junior Leaders

GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS:

- Consistent participation in Summit View Kids on the assigned days.
- Advance notification to Coordinator or Director prior to any absences (by student or parent).
- Willingness to help the adult staff with the children's needs.
- Openness to follow direction given by the Teacher or other adult staff according to the policies.
- Active participation with the children during the gathering time.
- Timely arrival to assigned class 20 minutes prior to the gathering time.
- On going participation in the Volunteer Training (when one is scheduled).
- Have an attitude that reflects a servant's heart.
- Participation in cleaning-up the class at the end of the gathering.
- Commitment to stay for the entire service and to check with the Teacher or Coordinator before leaving at the end of the gathering.
- Participate during Bible Stories and singing times by:
 - Guiding the children during Bible Story and singing times.
 - Encourage them in participation.
 - Assisting at craft time.
- Help the children at snack time by:
 - Washing your own hands first before handling any food, or water.
 - Distributing snack in the way the Teacher requests.
- Assist with clean up and dismissal before the gathering time ends by:
 - Putting away toys, puzzles, books and supplies.
 - Helping children exit with proper belongings.
 - Assist children to the room door when called by the Teacher. (Only Teachers return children to their parents.)

Remember that you are setting an example and the children will be looking to you as their role model. We want you to always be seen as appropriately and modestly dressed. Your goal is for the children to see Jesus and not you!
