LIFE LESSONS FROM THE BOOK OF PROVERBS

WEEK 3: MONEY

QUESTION ONE

Read Proverbs 3:9-10. What does it practically look like to honor God with our finances? Does honoring God with our finances always result in an abundance of finances for us?

Follow Up: If not, why should we honor God with our finances?

QUESTION TWO

Read Proverbs 3:5-10. How do verses 5-8 help us understand why we should use our wealth for God regardless of what benefit we see in it?

Follow Up: Consider the emphasis on trusting God over ourselves in 3:5-8

Follow Up: Have you ever seen God's provision in Your own life that proves you can trust Him?

QUESTION THREE

Read Proverbs 14:20-22, 31, 17:5, and James 2:1-9. How do we see favoritism show up in the way we treat those who have less than us? What are some of the problems with favoritism?

Follow Up: How do the scriptures call us to care for all people with righteousness, justice, and equity, as Proverbs 1:3 says?

QUESTION FOUR

Read Proverbs 15:16, 16:8, & 28:6. Why is it better to pursue righteousness than riches? What is the benefit of doing what's right? What are the consequences of getting wealthy through unjust means?

Follow Up: What are ways that you have actually seen this play out in real life?

QUESTION FIVE

Read Proverbs 30:7-9. What are the temptations of having much or little? Which do you find yourself relating to more right now? Do you feel the desire for contentment with simply having enough?

CLOSING: Read Proverbs 3:5-10 and 30:7-9 together as a prayer.
